RECTOR'S DIRECTIVE NO. 04/2020**ON REDUCING THE RISK OF INFECTION BY THE CORONAVIRUS COVID-19****I.**

The Rector of the Technical University of Košice (hereinafter referred to as „TUKE“) issues the second part of the Rector's Directive, which follows the Rector's Directive No. 03/2020:

On the basis of the statement of the TUKE Task Force, I hereby

order
in the period from 9 March 2020, 12:30pm to 21 March 2020,

in the interest of prevention of infectious diseases spreading at TUKE:

1. to suspend the classes for two weeks. The educational process will take the form of self-study, distance study or other suitable method. Details will be decided on by the Vice-Rector for Education, Deans of faculties, Heads of university-wide departments and persons delegated by them.

Responsible: Vice-Rector for Education, Deans of faculties and Heads of university-wide departments TUKE

2. to ensure
 - a) collective use of leave within the meaning of Article 111(2) of Act No. 311/2001 Coll. Labour Code as amended by subsequent provisions (hereinafter referred to as "Labour Code") or
 - b) to provide employees time off within the meaning of Article 141(3b) of the Labour Code or
 - c) to agree on working at home within the meaning of Article 52(5) of Labour Code with the employees, at all faculties and organizational units of TUKE.

This directive does not apply to employees working shifts and ensuring continuous operation, or other employees whose presence at workplace is required at the discretion of those responsible for the implementation of this directive.

Responsible: Bursar, Deans of faculties, and Heads of the organizational units of TUKE

3. to cancel all meetings of all academic self-governing bodies and all mass events at TUKE premises. Staff and students are advised to consider their participation in mass events outside the university

Responsible: Bursar, Chairman of the TUKE Academic Senate, Deans of faculties, and Heads of organizational units of TUKE

4. to cancel all business trips of employees in Slovakia or abroad until further notice.

Responsible: Bursar, Chairman of the TUKE Academic Senate, Deans of faculties, and Heads of organizational units of TUKE

At the same time, the Rector strongly recommends Slovak students who are staying at dormitories to go home during the suspension of classes.

For foreign students staying at dormitories, it is recommended to stay at the dormitories during the suspension of classes.

Please note that in case of infection outbreak at the dormitories; all students staying at dormitories will be subject to quarantine.

II.**Final provisions**

This directive shall enter into force and effect on 9 March 2020.
