RECTOR'S DIRECTIVE no. 16/2020**ON ENSURING THE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS, ACCOMODATION AND PROVIDING MEALS IN ŠDaJ TUKE
IN CONNECTION WITH THE RISK OF COVID-19 DISEASE CAUSED BY THE CORONAVIRUS – Part 2**

This Rector's Directive is issued in connection with current information on the development of spread of infectious viral disease COVID-19 caused by the coronavirus.

The Rector of the Technical University of Košice (hereinafter referred to as "TUKE") issues the second part of the Rector's Directive, which follows the Rector's Directive no. 15/2020.

I.**Teaching and teaching methods**

1. From 15 October 2020, I recommend the TUKE faculties to implement a distance method of teaching for all classes. In exceptional cases, Deans of the faculties decide on other method of teaching.

II.**Accommodation and meal provision**

1. I order Slovak students to leave temporarily the accommodation facilities of Student Dormitories and Canteens (hereinafter referred to as "ŠDaJ TUKE" or "ŠD") on mandatory basis, no later than on 21 October 2020. Students will be informed about the amount of the discount and the method of its application for leaving the accommodation facilities temporarily by a separate decision.
2. Only foreign students are allowed to stay at the accommodation facilities.
3. In cases eligible for special consideration, Slovak students may submit a request to be granted a dispensation to stay at the ŠD via e-mail to the accommodation departments of the relevant ŠD.
4. I recommend foreign students who are at TUKE within mobility programmes to consider their stay in the Slovak Republic with regard to the nature of the enrolled subjects and the possibility of completing them online.
5. ŠDaJ shall ensure the meal provision in accordance with the guidelines of Regional Office of Public Health.
6. More detailed conditions of temporary leaving from ŠDaJ accommodation facilities and meal provision will be published on the ŠDaJ website.

III.**TUKE staff**

1. The scheduling of working hours for working at the workplace or working from home is in the competence of deans of TUKE faculties, the relevant Vice-Rectors and Bursar of TUKE.

IV.**Final provisions**

1. All students and staff of TUKE are obliged to become acquainted with this Rector's Directive and comply with its provisions.
2. This Rector's Directive will be published on the TUKE website in the Section "TUKE Legislation", as well as in the section "Studies".
3. All students and staff of TUKE are obliged to follow and comply with the currently issued measures of the Public Health Authority of the SR, the Ministry of Education, Science, Research and sport of the SR, and other authorities and ministries concerning the fight against the coronavirus.
4. The Directive shall enter into force and effect on the day of its publication.
